Thanks to Allied Martial Arts Gym, the people who brought KL-ites the *Thai Kickboxing Grand Prix* for the first time last year, your night out at Atmosphere will be filled with bouts of angst and glory with the one-on-one sparring of *muay* Thai fighters.

Local, Thai and European kickboxers will be facing off in three categories: lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight. There'll be 16 quarter-finalists, out of which only eight will qualify for the semi-finals, so you can bet each of them will be battling their guts out to avoid getting eliminated.

If, for any reason, you can't attend the outing of 7 May, don't fret. Two more quarter-final events have been scheduled for 4 June and 2 July, whereas the semis and finals will be in August and September respectively. If last year's debut event, which ended in many knock-out victories, is an indication of what you can expect this year, then you don't want to miss this series of fight nights.
